The plant is located on land off Harbour Way (A4241), near Margam in South Wales, in an area designated for commercial and industrial development. Built on a 3.98 hectares site the buildings are surrounded by a 6209m² (66,834ft²) concreted yard plus asphalt access roads and car park.
