found were convoluted and contradictory with costs fluctuating without consistency.

In his hometown of Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire, Nick began exploring well-known pot banks such as Spode and Wedgwood and enquired as to where their kilns were being supplied from. Being situated in such an appropriate location,

Nick found that the knowledge and materials needed to bring his idea into fruition were right under his nose.



Over the next six years Nick saw his pizza oven idea evolve from a simple interest into a successful business. As the business grew so did the number of enquiries it received and Nick's wife Sam subsequently joined the team to aid Nick in tackling the ever increasing work load, a logical step after having spent years observing Nick's emphatic pizza oven passion.

The pair reinvested almost every penny that the business made back into the business and soon saw trade exceed anticipations. Nick told us "We followed a simple formula. Our raw materials are recycled from the pottery industry. These are high quality refractory materials that ware (cups, saucers and plates) sit on. A lot are single use and are then discarded. Although the cost of sorting and recycling is still quite high, we still end up with better quality raw materials, not to mention savings on storage."

Nick continues "We then grew the business organically, from our garage home, to a small unit then

onto a showroom and manufacturing base. Every year we improved a little in each department. The most important was the moulds we used to cast our ovens. We went from plywood and fibreglass to plasma cut steel. Our ovens got better year on year. We must have got things right from the start though, as 2019 has seen six previous customers come back and purchase a pizza oven in their new property. Jeff the owner of Potbank hotel in Stoke who was our second ever customer, commissioned a fantastic bottle oven to be built on the former Spode factory that the hotel had been converted from."

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TV show prepares to lift manhole on sewer cleaning team



A popular TV show revealing the grimy side of life in Britain is preparing to show wastewater engineers working for Lanes Group battling fatbergs

in London sewers. The highly-skilled and dedicated sewer 'flushers' were filmed tackling the large fat blockages on behalf of Thames Water for the documentary series Grime and Punishment.

The new series of Grime and Punishment begins on Thursday June 13th 2019 at 8pm. The Lanes and Thames Water sewer cleaning team is scheduled to be shown in action in episode 2 on 20th June.

Lanes is the wastewater network service maintenance partner for Thames Water. Its trunk sewer walking team is at the forefront of efforts to keep London's sewers flowing freely. One sewer cleaning project filmed by the documentary makers needed a team of 10 personnel, using high-tech jetting and vacuumation equipment and a lot of elbow grease to clear a sewer that was 50% blocked with fat.

It took two days to clear the blockage along a 12-metre length of Victorian egg-shaped brick sewer in Rotherhithe, South East London, which was 1.2 metres high and 0.8 metres wide. Lanes personnel wore mini digital camera to show viewers what conditions were like inside the sewer as they shovelled tonnes of gloopy fat into a powerful vacuumation hose. Thames Water hopes the programme will encourage more people to observe its request to 'Bin it - don't block it' to keep sewers clear of unnecessary waste.

Dublin's new Central Plaza conversion uses Denso Protection





Joiners in the South West also proved to be the most bump-free van drivers, registering no at-fault collision claims. Electricians proved to be the bad boys of tradesmen, with 19 per cent of insurance quote requests already carrying a motoring conviction.

Scotland was also the worst region for sparky van drivers, with 28% of electricians registering convictions.
