

Construction dust



Regular inhalation, of even small quantities of construction dust, can damage the lungs and respiratory airways over the course of time. Some diseases can develop quite quickly, but in many cases, it can take 10 to 30 years before symptoms become apparent.

What is construction dust?

Construction dust is a broad term, there are many different types of dust one may be exposed to in a construction environment.

Silica dust arises during work with materials containing silica, such as concrete, mortar and sandstone.

Wood dust arises during work with softwood, hardwood and wood-based materials such as MDF and plywood.

Other types of dust arise during work with plaster, glass wool, mineral wool, marble, etc.





The Skypark Business Park is located just North of Exeter International Airport, Devon and East of the M5 off Junction 29. The Park is a Joint Venture Partnership between St.Moden, the UK's leading regeneration specialist and Devon County Council.

The development, when complete, will cover 130,200 m2 (1.4 million ft²) and comprise of office, industrial and manufacturing premises. Ancillary retail development and a hotel are also planned as part of the scheme.



Set in landscaped grounds, it includes numerous car parks requiring effective surface water drainage.

the restoration of a Victorian tavern light from an art deco building in the centre of Swansea. The building is currently a Holland & Barrett store and QiRC were carrying out renovation works. The lantern was no longer illuminated and was in a poor condition. It was taken to a workshop for comprehensive repair.

The lantern was dismantled, with the remains of the roof being removed and the glass panels carefully taken out. Remaining paint and rust was removed manually before heavily wasted steel sections were replaced. The original roof was repaired and the missing heart to one side of the

finial remade in copper.

The frame was completely repainted using an alkyd oil system. Original broken glass panes were repaired with a UV resistant adhesive resin before the lantern was re-assembled. The glass panes were secured using a modern glazing compound before the repaired roof was re-fitted. A new electrical fitting was added inside, and fly mesh fitted to keep insects out. The lantern was refitted by QiRC in early March 2021.

Qualifying costs can include surveys, excavations, soil/groundwater treatments, staff costs, required materials and subcontractor costs. Claims can be made for categories of derelict land. This can be advised with relevance to time periods when land could be considered for dereliction.

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



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
