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Hauraton drainage systems at Bonus Arena - Hull Venue

Built on brown-field land located on the edge of the main shopping district in Hull and adjacent to Princes Quay, the Bonus Arena – Hull Venue and its associated multi storey car park were opened in August 2018. The £36 million development progresses the legacy of the social and economic impact generated by Hull's 2017 UK City of Culture status.

The Arena, designed by AFL Architects, is a state-of-the-art music and events complex





with a flexible capacity of up to 3,500 people. The facility can provide a venue for concerts or corporate conferences in an 800 seat auditorium. A 2000m² adaptable space can be utilised for sporting events or exhibitions and trade shows.

Surrounding the Bonus Arena is a public realm laid with grey stone paving and landscaped by re-form Landscape Architecture Limited with trees, lawns, flowerbeds and permanent stone seating. An effective surface water drainage system was essential to ensure all weather access to the venue. 140 metres of Hauraton RECYFIX® PRO 100 channels with FIBRETEC® heel-safe gratings were chosen for the job which blended well with the stone paving and would resist damage from applied grit rock salt in freezing weather.

The material, PA-GF used to make the FIBRETEC® grating, was especially developed by Hauraton; the tough, UV resistant, fibre reinforced moulding offers high stability and huge strength for its weight. Complying with loading category Class C250 (BSEN 1433) the grating can easily take the weight of commercial delivery vehicles. The design is a real innovation as its non-corrosive material provides a visually appealing surface finish that retains its colour.

The slots are super smooth, elliptical openings with the moulded bars having slightly raised triangular bosses along their outside edges. As well as providing an



elegant appearance, the feature ensures surface water is directed into the slots.

The RECYFIX[®] channel component is made from 100% recycled PP. The PRO 100 model is factory fitted with the FIBRETEC[®] grating and only weighs 4.6kg, so the unit was easy to handle and quickly installed on site.



Hauraton high capacity channel system drains extensive car park at Skypark, Exeter

The Skypark Business Park is located just North of Exeter International Airport, Devon and East of the M5 off Junction 29. The Park is a Joint Venture Partnership between St.Moden, the UK's leading regeneration specialist and Devon County Council.

The development, when complete, will cover 130,200 m² (1.4 million ft²) and comprise of office, industrial and manufacturing premises. Ancillary retail development and a hotel are also planned as part of the scheme. Set in landscaped grounds, it includes numerous car parks requiring effective surface water



drainage. In this phased development, three sizes of the Hauraton RECYFIX® MONOTEC high capacity surface drainage system have so far been installed in the extensive asphalt car parks servicing Skypark Units 10 and 20.



145 metres of MONOTEC 100/230mm, 136 metres of 100/280 and 45 metre of 100/380. 100mm is the channel grating width and the internal dimension. The 230mm (overall height) channel model has a cross-section of 190.5cm², the 280mm, 245.5cm², and the 380mm, 355.5cm². The 326 metres of channel supplied provide a total hydraulic capacity of just over 7717 litres.

Hauraton Limited introduced the MONOTEC system just over two years ago. Skypark joins the numerous installations successfully completed in the United Kingdom.

The MONOTEC one metre long channel component is of a sturdy monolithic design where the HEELSAFE grating and the tongue and groove linking system are integral to the channel moulding.

The whole unit is made of tough, virtually unbreakable polypropylene (PP) formulated to be very resistant to daily temperature



fluctuations from frost conditions to strong sunlight, including the Ultra Violet (UV) spectrum. PP is naturally resistant to deicing salt. Complying with the requirements of EN 1433, the PP is given its UV resistance by adding just sufficient stabiliser so that the structural strength of the material is unaffected and a consistent appearance is maintained. The MONOTEC channels have a loading category of up to Class D400.

Cat Jones, Hauraton's Project Manager for South West UK was particularly please with the comments she received from Sam Reed, Site Manager for G Works Construction "Sam was surprised how strong and sturdy these MONOTEC PP channels were. Cutting mitres was easy on site and no accidental damage to any component was experienced.

The tongue and groove features on the channels provides easy assembly of the moulded components and facilitates the alignment of the channel run so reducing installation time for the groundwork contractor".

For its clients, the company provides a full suite of assessments from vitality tests, tree root radar scans, sonic and electronic tomography, and stability testing of trees.

'Tree Radar' is the latest service made available from Barnes Associates Ltd. Through the use of its Ground Penetrating Radar system, it can detect tree roots as small as 1cm through any surface without





making a mess. The data is mapped and scaled to the surrounding area and delivered to the client as a full report with images, technical data and recommendations of best practice in moving forward.

Trees can have a lot to cope with such as excavations close by, harsh pruning, drought, even pests and diseases. All these factors and more can start the decline or mortality spiral eventually leading to the removal of the tree. Tree Vitality Testing is a service provided which is a useful tool used to monitor 'how happy' a tree is, giving opportunity to implement management early. The test takes 30 minutes, is non invasive and involves the measurement of excess levels of far-red light emitted as part of early photosynthesis and chlorophyll levels which is then compared against a global benchmark figure for its species.

Another service used to prevent the deterioration of a tree's health is the use of Electronic and Sonic Tomography. Electronic tomography uses an electrical current to measure resistance levels which can even



identify a range of subterranean pathogens that are otherwise usually hard to detect. It can also detect fungal activity in its earliest stage allowing suitable management of the tree and its growing area to be initiated to prolong and improve the trees lifespan. Sonic Tomography is an advanced decay detection in trees. It uses soundwaves to find decay and cavities and through a non-invasive approach there is no harm to the tree. The results can be instant and can produce a tree safety factor which can be used as evidence to support any specialist pruning works, further management of the tree or the removal of the tree on safety grounds.

A method commonly referred to as 'Tree Pulling' enables an assessment of a whole tree's safety to be undertaken, which otherwise can be difficult. Alternatively, Barnes Associates Ltd can measure the response of a tree to natural wind loads recorded using an anemometer near the tree.


The company can offer a fully

comprehensive tree stability check with its Dynaroot system. It provides an insight into the tree's response to real site forces. Where access is restricted, or stability is in question from multiple directions, Barnes Associates Ltd can assess trees by measuring the response to a known wind load. This can be used to forecast a trees response to an unexpected storm event and provide a safety factor based upon engineering standards.

In recent changes, Barnes Associates Ltd has recently expanded its workforce by hiring a new surveyor. To increase its capacity, the company has also moved to a larger office to cater for more storage of its ever-growing technical equipment and training facilities. Moving forward, Barnes Associates Ltd intend to increase the use of further assessments which will ultimately save trees from being felled. The company is also working on in-house training CPD's, which will eventually allow Barnes Associates Ltd to provide training courses to other companies to help them improve their knowledge. Post COVID-19, Barnes Associates Ltd has changed its approach and is now working via a hybrid system to enable flexibility for its workers. Working partly in the office, out on site and from home, gives a varied week and keeps the working environment interesting for all employees.







The steel framework was powder coated in the colour of choice of the client & comes with a 5-year structural warranty. Each post was fitted with a 50mm thick, 1.5m long padded post protector in different colours so as to optimise the appearance of the structure.

The entire structure has been designed & manufactured in the UK to maximise the backup & support for all component parts.



Construction dust







Knowsley-based Livv Housing Group is working with Merseyside Fire & Rescue Service to help crews improve their emergency response to dealing with high-rise incidents.

A major training exercise involving the simulation of a fire recently took place at Livu's unoccupied Gaywood Green tower block, in Kirkby.

Gaywood Green is thought to be the only empty high-rise building in the country being used by a fire service to undertake live practice scenarios.

Eight fire engines, two support vehicles and an aerial platform ladder vehicle rushed to the scene. Around 80 emergency service staff took part with actors posing as residents.

The exercise gave new firefighters the opportunity to experience a realistic fire and evacuation scenario.

Learning outcomes will be shared locally and nationally to improve safety and hopefully reduce the possibility of future high-rise fires.

Tony Cahill, Executive Director at Livv Housing Group, said:

"The safety and protection of our residents is of the upmost importance to us and we are proud to be working in partnership with Merseyside Fire & Rescue Service to help them prepare for high rise emergency incidents.

"As far as we are aware, Gaywood Green is the only empty high rise building in the country that is being used for exercises like this, and MFRS will be able to share learnings with other fire services around the country."

Dave Watson, Group Manager at Merseyside Fire & Rescue Service, added:

"We work closely with housing providers and local authorities to ensure the safety of those living within high rise buildings and exercises like this are vital - we would like to thank Liw and the local community for giving us the opportunity to carry out a large exercise in a realistic setting."
