These Open-Loop Ground Source Heat Pump Systems suit the geology of the South East of England for use in small commercial and domestic environments. Initially the company focused on drilling water supply and soakaway boreholes plus the installation and maintenance of sewage treatment systems, however, noticing a compatibility between construction of wate supply boreholes and the growing Renewable Energy market, it made sense for the company to invest in the Open Loop Ground Source Heat Pump market too.

One of the best ways to reduce fossil fuels and stop the destruction of our planets is to use heat pumps to provide heating and hot water for use in homes. The Open Loop system is the most efficient ground source heat pump option, and helps reduce carbon footprint, enable greater water efficiency, with minimal installation disruption and visual impact, and provides hot water up to 65°C all year round.

The past 12 months has been H.D. Services Ltd.'s best financial year yet. "Throughout COVID-19, we managed to continue operating and replenish staff. We adapted our operating procedures and best working practices. We operate in both the construction and the renewables sectors, and thankfully, neither of these sectors appear to have suffered greatly from the current economic crisis," stated Rebecca.


Direct Hoist's success can be attributed to its founder, Rob Wilson, a man whose dedication to business is equalled only by his attitude towards his employees' welfare.

Currently thriving despite reduced staffing, Direct Hoist is a livingwage employer (more than minimum wage) and has two vacancies for trainee hoist installers. Each will be educated in the multifaceted skills that are crucial for the specialised nature of construction hoists including product types, electrical systems, fault-finding, assembly, disassembly and reconfiguration into alternative layouts.

Direct Hoist then enrols trainees into NVQ schemes, manufacturer courses and the all-important healthand-safety tuition. Indeed, several Direct Hoist staff have NVQ Level 3 qualifications - the equivalent of a

Rob says, "We have an exceptional reputation for safety. Ours is a very specialised industry, heavily governed by legislation - which is probably why there are fewer than 15 hoist companies in the UK.

"Our most popular units are the 300 Z goods hoist (ideal for barrows, boards and roofing equipment) and the 500 Z/ZP transport platform, which can be used as an 850kg goods-only hoist or up to 500kg for personnel. It's a great, versatile hoist; it can be left- or right-handed and has the facility to move around the loading/unloading ramp."

Direct Hoist relishes the scope to erect equipment in areas many would consider impractical or too inaccessible. A recent project involved installation of a 58m hoist in Newcastle, where the entire platform had to be stripped and fed through a car park with 1.8m head height.

A popular usage of hoists is to speed up the construction of scaffolding, which again might involve some pretty creative thinking.

Rob reports, "Because platforms can be configured to different widths, 21ft scaffold tube can be carried vertically and safely, on a much smaller footprint."

No wonder so many scaffolding companies are now buying their own installation platforms. Similarly, citybased furniture removal specialists have discovered the convenience of owning their own hoists, which prove invaluable when delivering large three-piece suites into apartments through high windows.

Needless to say, Direct Hoist is ideally placed to offer sales and servicing of top-quality GEDA hoists to ensure customers choose exactly the right equipment - not just for their current circumstances but to allow scope for expansion - and stay safe throughout their working life.


"I'm glad to say we managed to pull through and come out smiling. We've done very well lately - we recently had five hoists at one hospital alone and we're continually investing in new equipment.





The separator sits on its specifically designed recycled plastic slider, which allows adjustment and is coupled to a simple outlet pipe which is detachable for cleaning. As the only company to provide a soakaway vent, both models are an industry first.

The Primo XL bears all the features of the Primo but is larger in width allowing room for a handwash basin and built-in sawdust box, instead of the pallet base the XL gets a redesigned solid wood base, which still allows for easy transportation. Other products include showers, washrooms, and disability facilities, camping and campsite products, reclaimed furniture, gifts and homeware.

Recently, the company has taken on a second workshop to keep up with customer demand. Joe explained the effects of COVID-19, "With the rise in staycations, we've seen an increase in orders,







The building is currently a Holland & Barrett store and QiRC were carrying out renovation works. The lantern was no longer illuminated and was in a poor condition. It was taken to a workshop for comprehensive repair.

The lantern was dismantled, with the remains of the roof being removed and the glass panels carefully taken out. Remaining paint and rust was removed manually before heavily wasted steel sections were replaced. The original roof was repaired and the missing heart to one side of the finial remade in copper.

The frame was completely repainted using an alkyd oil system. Original broken glass panes were repaired with a UV resistant adhesive resin before the lantern was re-assembled. The glass panes were secured using a modern glazing compound before the repaired roof was re-fitted. A new electrical fitting was added inside, and fly mesh fitted to keep insects out. The lantern was refitted by QiRC in early March 2021.



Breaking the nutrient neutrality deadlock

Two years ago, Natural England advised a number of local authorities in the Solent catchment area to halt the determination of planning applications unless the developments could prove they were nutrient neutral. And the issue is spreading. David Stagg, technical product specialist for wastewater experts Graf UK, advises housebuilders and developers how to break the deadlock.

Concerns about the effects of nutrient over-enrichment within some European-designated nature conservation areas, including those in the Solent and Poole Harbour, have existed for many years.

However, Natural England has now updated its advice on the complex issue following a judgement by the Court of Justice of the European Union in two joined cases related to the EU Habitats Directive, now known as the Dutch nitrogen case, or even more simply, the Dutch case.

The ruling has meant even greater scrutiny of the water quality of Special Areas of Conservation (SAC) and Special Protection Areas (SPA) across the UK, with the building of residential properties particularly being linked to excess nutrients entering nearby water sources.

High levels of these nutrients, which come directly from wastewater treatment discharges and indirectly from farm drainage/runoff, sewage/silage systems, enter streams and rivers, causing excessive growth of green algae, which smothers rare habitats and wildlife.

While the construction industry largely ignored the advice at the time, thousands of planning applications for tens of thousands of much-needed new homes now remain on hold while housebuilders and developers struggle to find a long-term viable solution. Some local authorities are even dismissing appeals for single dwellings if the schemes cannot be shown to be nutrient neutral.

Morgan Sindall did manage to persuade Hampshire County Council that its Later Living £13 million Addenbrooke extra-care scheme in Gosport could be nutrient neutral with the installation of water-saving flow regulators... but this was at a cost of £50,000.

Another idea is to take farmland out of agricultural production and get developers to turn it into nature reserves against which they could buy credits to offset their nitrate discharge. It's a slant on carbon neutrality but comes at a cost to them of £1,235 per kilo of nitrogen. And this is not an option for brownfield sites because they will not result in any agricultural land being taken out of production.



However, a long-term viable solution already exists. The development of this technology was implemented more than 15 years ago for Scandinavia, where the phosphate element of nutrient elimination is already common practice.

More than 5,000 wastewater treatment systems with this technology have already been supplied into Scandinavia by Graf to meet these challenging discharge constraints (as with the more challenging nitrate removal in Sweden), which uniquely achieve an independently tested* 0.4mg/l of phosphate removal, only days after commissioning.

Reductions in phosphates as low as 0.2mg/l have even been achieved on a Graf UK installation at the award-winning Scottish attraction Loch Leven's Larder, a working farm, restaurant, deli, gift shop and playground on the banks of Loch Leven, which attracts more than 300 visitors a day in high season. Renowned for its wintering and breeding wildfowl, the Loch has been designated a SPA by SEPA (the Scottish Environment Protection Agency).

To comply with SEPA's particularly stringent phosphate and nitrate discharge requirements, the attraction needed to replace its deficient wastewater treatment system with one that limited phosphate discharge to 2mg/l. The new Klaro XXL system is now up and running and is operating to 0.2mg/l (Graf UK's One2Clean system can also be set up for phosphate removal).

The system can either be supplied as a single-chamber tank featuring

a single airlift pumping process, or as a split chamber which utilises multiple airlift pumping processes. The system performance is extremely effective, processing the waste up to a 99% treatment coefficient. The treatment technology can also be combined with precast concrete tanks. Both use sequence batch reactor (SBR) airlift technology, which is widely recognised as being the most efficient for wastewater treatment and results in extremely low volumes of sewage sludge.

The process is wholly controlled in the tank, with precipitants attaching themselves to the phosphate so they sink to the bottom of the chamber for removal by normal desludging.

Another benefit of the more advanced system is it comes with underload detection as standard, which allows it to operate efficiently with up to 75% underload – a benefit particularly for second homes, which are often left unoccupied for long periods of time.

Carbon dosing is an additional option, which can aid nitrate removal by adding a carbon (sugar) solution to the system, which feeds/stimulates the micro-organisms, so they continue to produce high-quality effluent during underload. If the system is likely to drop below the 75% underload threshold the carbon dosing makes up the shortfall to ensure low-odour and even odourless treatment and extended times between tank emptying.

Natural England's focus on nutrient neutrality is now moving from Hampshire to Herefordshire, Kent, Dorset and Somerset (where there are currently 1,000 developments on hold), forcing some local planning authorities to propose their own, immediate/short-term solutions.

And Natural Resources Wales (NRW) are believed to be taking on nutrient neutrality across the whole country, centred around 11 river regions.

It's just as well a long-term viable solution knows no borders!

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Do you claim Land Remediation costs? If not, why not?



Remediation Tax Relief is one of the best kept secrets in the **UK** construction and building industries. It is



available to recover costs of carrying out remediation work prior to receiving planning permission to render the land useable for new developments.

Few companies claim this valuable relief: why?

Qualifying criteria are few. You must be a registered UK corporate entity and the owner of the land. You cannot claim if you own the land and caused the contamination. From this point most costs associated with the clean-up measures, disposal of waste and making good the finished projects form the basis for cost evaluation and submission of the claim.

Known contaminated land can be claimed for. Derelict land that has remained unused from the earlier of 1st April 1998 or date of acquisition can also form the basis of a claim, especially if it has suffered tipping and illegal waste disposal

Since Land Remediation must be undertaken before any construction works begin, it is advised to consider remediation preparations early. All contributory costs should be identified and recorded. These are wide and include your own company costs of labour, management, sub-contractors, suppliers, travel and subsistence costs, surveys, tests, disposal and replacement of soil and making good. Generally, brown field sites and land that has existing buildings will be contaminated, especially where older buildings are suspected of containing asbestos in any form Used land can contain old foundations, utility services, hydrocarbon and chemicals whatever. If remediation surveys discover radon gas emissions, Japanese Knotweed and any other invasive plant species and contaminants deposited through earlier occupier activities, these too can be included in remediation costs. Where buildings contain asbestos, costs of removal and either demolition or in-situ encapsulation and sealing of the asbestos elements is a claimable cost.

The definition of what is contaminated land is peculiar to land remediation relief legislation and is broader than for planning purposes as in Environmental Protection Act 1990. It is beneficial to know land remediation relief is available before purchase of land. This reduces possible uncertainty

The enhancement factor is 150% on all identified costs.

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Land Remediation Tax Relief



Land remediation is a tax relief available to property developers and landowners.

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To qualify for Land Remediation Tax Relief your company must have incurred costs on cleaning up land or buildings considered to be in a contaminated state. The scope of costs allowed is generous.

You must be registered as a limited company in the UK and be the owner of the land or building at the time of the remediation work. In addition, the land or building must be owned either as a freehold or longer-term leasehold,

Common examples of qualifying contamination:

- Ground and landfill gases
- Japanese Knotweed
- Sulphate contamination in soil and concrete
- Arsenic
- Removal of redundant utility services and concrete foundations

Qualifying costs can include surveys, excavations, soil and groundwater treatments, staff costs, materials and subcontractor costs. Claims can be made for categories of derelict land. This can be advised with relevance to time periods when land could be considered for derelict status.

Regardless of the industry you operate within, if you've acquired land or buildings in a contaminated or derelict state for intended commercial use, you could claim.
